



CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2011

WINEMAKER:	Abrie Beeslaar
VARIETALS:	100 %, Cabernet Sauvignon
ORIGIN:	Stellenbosch
CLIMATE:	Cold and long winter with good rainfall. Great ripening conditions.
AGE OF VINES:	On average 21 years
SOIL:	Decomposed granite and Hutton soils with a high clay content which assist with water retention.
TRELLIS OF VINES:	5 Wire hedge
YIELD:	4.5 tons/ha – 2900 lit./ha
VINIFICATION:	5.5 days on skins in open fermenters @ 28 °C – cap punched manually every 2nd hour.
DESCRIPTION:	Full bodied, deep ruby red colour. Spicy mocha, chocolate and tea leaf flavours – classic in style with a long though dry finish.
MATURATION:	24 months in 60% new 225 lit. French Nevers, with 40 % 2nd fill.
FOOD SUGGESTION:	Red meat and cheese dishes.
